


Figure 2: A special authoring wizard allow to quickly generate a set of staggered flashcards with increasing difficulty.




Figure 3: Flashcards are practiced with a classic reveal-score flow.




Figure 4: Harder flashcards will not come up in practice unless all their prerequisite flashcards are practiced (meaning they came up at least once and are currently not due according to the ts-fsrs [3] algorithm).
